A DAY IN THE RECORDING STUDIO

This workshop will occur over a six hour day and will focus on the music recording process. Participants are introduced to a professional studio setting, collaborating with a band/artist(s) and will be guided through a recording session with a qualified audio engineer; primarily learning the recording & mixing process utilizing tools and practices current in the industry. This workshop offers introductory hands-on experience in one field of Audio Production and presents the benefit of technical training for a prospective career in this and other fields throughout the Audio Production Industry such as Sound for Film, Television, and Gaming, Live Sound, and Radio Production.

Includes a 30 minute lunch break. ** Meals are not provided, participants should pack a lunch.

All selected participants will possess:

2. Knowledge of computers, strong work ethic and an ability to collaborate in a team environment.

3. Include your character reference letter issue by a non-family member.
